WHEREAS, the University of Mississippi Rebels 2003 baseball team finished the baseball season with an overall record of 35-27 and an appearance at the 2003 Houston Baseball Regional under the coaching of Mike Bianco and assistant coaches Dan McDonnell, Clint Carver, and Kyle Bunn; and

WHEREAS, the Rebels recorded their sixth straight thirty-win season and tied a school record with seventeen SEC wins; and

WHEREAS, freshman first baseman/left-handed pitcher Stephen Head was named the 2003 SEC Freshman of the Year and the Collegiate Baseball National Freshman of the Year; and

WHEREAS, Stephen Head and Seth Smith were named to the USA National Baseball Team and will represent the United States at the Pan Am Games this summer; and

WHEREAS, T.J. Beam was drafted in the tenth round by the New York Yankees in this year's Major League Baseball First-Year Player Draft:
