- I. Report and discussion on survey of classrooms (Attachment A)
 - ⇒ SDE conducted this survey and found that 58% of public classrooms have Internet-accessible computers.
 - ⇒ 5,731 classrooms are wired—these are the easiest and should be the first to receive computers.
- II. Report and discussion on computer specifications and costs (Attachment B)
 - Option A Intel Celeron or AMD K6 500 Mhz (average cost \$1,081)
 - Option B Intel Pentium III 500 Mhz (average cost \$1,263)
 - ⇒ SDE and ITS Recommended Option
 - Option C Intel Pentium III 600 Mhz (average cost \$1,591)
- III. Discussion of procurement options (Attachment C)
 - Purchase Directly from Current Micro EPL
 - Letter of Configuration (LOC) from Micro EPL
 - Request for proposals (RFP)
 - ⇒ Although this requires the longest time for procurement, it provides open opportunity for all vendors to participate.
- IV. Distribution and Instillations (Attachment D)
 - Application Process
 - ⇒ This provides prioritization for all schools. The working group recommends starting with the 5,700 classrooms that are wired and then working on those that are not.

 - \Rightarrow Entergy
 - \Rightarrow AOL
 - Legislative appropriations
 - ⇒ \$2 million from HB 1496
