RE: Location Announcement of EOH Energy, LLC

This event is about the announcement of a new ethanol facility in Greenville. This is a locally-owned and developed project, and is the 3<sup>rd</sup> largest industrial project in the county's history. The projected cost is \$58 million, and 35-40 new jobs will be created. It also supports the agribusiness industry through the renewable source of fuel (corn).

MDA has not really been involved in the project to this point, but there are talks underway with the state now regarding rail access to the facility.

You will be introduced by Al Brock, president of the Industrial Foundation of Washington County. Other speakers include Mayor Paul Artman, Jr., and the president of the Board of Supervisors, Alfred Rankins, Sr.
