

A Proclamation
by
Governor Ronnie Musgrove

TO THE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE:

By virtue of the provisions of Section 121 of the Constitution of the State of Mississippi, and in conformity with the Proclamation issued August 30, 2002, I, Ronnie Musgrove, Governor of the State of Mississippi, do herewith submit in writing the following additional matters for the consideration of the Legislature in the Third Extraordinary Session convening on Thursday, September 5, 2002, at 10:00 a.m., to wit:

1. An act to authorize the State Bond Commission to issue general obligation bonds of the State of Mississippi in an amount not to exceed Twenty Million Dollars (\$20,000,000), with:
 - (i) up to Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) for deposit to the Disaster Assistance Trust Fund for the provision of the state portion of emergency funds necessary for the repair, replacement and restoration of facilities, including those on the campus of The Mississippi University for Women, damaged and destroyed by the tornado of November 10, 2002, to be spent in compliance with state and federal laws and regulations governing contributions, reimbursements and replacement funds in connection with emergency relief, and
 - (ii) up to Ten Million Dollars (\$10,000,000) for deposit to the State Public School Building Fund for capital improvements in connection with public school buildings and related facilities specifically for the Columbus Municipal School District as well as other school districts for which such funds are provided for.
