

A Proclamation
by
Governor Ronnie Musgrove

TO THE MEMBERS OF THE LEGISLATURE:

By virtue of the provisions of Section 121 of the Constitution of the State of Mississippi, and in conformity with the Proclamation issued July 25, 2002, I, Ronnie Musgrove, Governor of the State of Mississippi, do herewith submit in writing the following additional matters for the consideration of the Legislature in the Extraordinary Session convening on Tuesday, July 30, 2002, at 10:00 a.m., to wit:

1. An Act to amend Chapter 135, Laws of 2002 (Senate Bill No. 3163), to revise Section 1 to specify the amount of general funds appropriated to the Department of Corrections to be \$227,725,528 and Section 3 to specify the amount of general funds appropriated to the Department of Corrections for the support and maintenance of prisons operated by private companies to be \$48,717,913 and to remove language restricting the transfer of funds.
2. An Act to amend House Bill 1794 enacted by the Mississippi Legislature in the Regular Session of 2002 to remove from Section 5 language restricting the transfer by the Department of Finance and Administration and the expenditure or obligation by the Division of Medicaid of an amount exceeding twenty-five percent of appropriated funds in a quarterly allotment of Fiscal Year 2003.
3. An Act to authorize the Board of Trustees of the Jackson-George Regional Library System to provide library services to Naval Station Pascagoula.
