WHEREAS, in 1964, nearly 70 technicians representing 17 states organized the American Society of Certified Engineering Technicians (ASCET); and

WHEREAS, the purpose of this organization is to obtain recognition for the contribution of engineering technicians to the national welfare, to cooperate with the engineering and scientific societies, to strengthen the engineering technician, and to assist the educational, social, economic and ethical development of the engineering technician; and

WHEREAS, the Thirty-ninth Annual Meeting of the American Society of Certified Engineering Technicians is scheduled to occur in Jackson, Mississippi, during the week of June 23 through June 26, 2003; and

WHEREAS, it is fitting that citizens recognize ASCET and the contributions of engineering technicians during the time this meeting is being held

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ronnie Musgrove, Governor of the State of Mississippi, hereby proclaim June 23 through June 26, 2003, as
