- Leadership is action, not position
  - Mississippi National Guard and 172<sup>nd</sup>
     Airlift Wing didn't earn reputation by just following orders
  - You earned it because you have done
     your job and continue to do your job –
     better than anyone else

- Morning of September 11, 2001, I asked General Lipscomb a simple question: "Is the Mississippi National Guard ready?"
  - His answer was just as simple: "Yes, sir, we are."
- The best are always ready to answer their country's call
  - No doubt that you are the best
  - o You've proven that for the past 50 years
- ■Incredible history of the 172<sup>nd</sup>
  - Started as the 183<sup>rd</sup> Tactical
     Reconnaissance Squadron in 1953, the
     only Night Photo Reconnaissance unit in
     the country

- Flew the 1000<sup>th</sup> support mission into
   Vietnam in June 1967
- Led relief efforts in aftermath of Hurricane Camille in 1969
- First Air National Guard unit to win
   John Pesch Trophy for sustained
   outstanding performance in flying safety
- Over 200,000 accident-free flying hours and ten Air Force Outstanding Unit Awards
- The reputation of the 172<sup>nd</sup> grows stronger still with support of war against terrorism
  - 55 members still on active duty in support of Operation Enduring Freedom and Operation Noble Eagle

- Your response to America's call has been swift and admirable
  - o In recent months, we've watched men and women of the Mississippi National Guard answer the call to service in places we know, and some we don't
- Deployments have gone to the Middle East, Asia, and locations that remain classified
  - This much we do know: The Mississippi
     National Guard is ready
  - o Wherever you go, you are well-trained, and you'll get the job done

- As commander-in-chief of the Mississippi National Guard, I can't express enough the *pride* I feel knowing that you're serving your state and your nation
  - This much I do know for sure when
     America needs the *very best*, the call is made to *Mississippi*
- You are the ones called on by your country because you have proven yourselves time and time again
  - You've set a high standard for others to follow

- Impact of your example seen in the tremendous recruiting numbers for the Mississippi National Guard
  - o We lead the nation in recruiting
  - Actually second behind Guam, but we're also a little bigger
- When I took office, I told General Lipscomb
  I wanted to increase the strength of the
  Guard, and that's what has happened
  - o Last three years have seen gain of more than 500 new soldiers
  - All this after a nine year period with no new recruits

- Just as important, the number of recruits who joined the Mississippi National Guard straight out of high school jumped as well, from 62% to 82%
  - Role of the Guard in serving as a positive influence for our young people has never been stronger
  - Extremely proud of the fact that you are in our schools working with our kids
- Read Colonel Brock's article about new mentoring program in recent issue of "The Mockingbird"
  - o Commend you for this great effort
  - o Encourage you to get involved

- You've had a proud history in the 172<sup>nd</sup>, and that history is about to enter a new phase
  - o C-17 Globemaster is on its way
  - o 172<sup>nd</sup> is first Air Guard unit to get the C-
  - Only fitting that the nation's best new plane comes to the nation's best Air
     Guard unit
- ■Excited about the C-17 program and what it means to the 172<sup>nd</sup> and to Mississippi
  - Know you will set the standard for other units around the country

- It's the leadership of people like General Lipscomb that make a difference
  - o It's the leadership of every one of you here today, the men and women of the 172<sup>nd</sup>, that makes a difference
  - You make the Mississippi National Guard the best in the nation
- You're the backbone of America's military, and you are setting a new standard of excellence
  - I'm proud of your work, and I'm proud to tell your story to others around our great country
