## A Proclamation By Governor Ronnie Musgrove

**WHEREAS**, in June 1903, Mr. Gregory M. Luce, a native of Grand Rapids, Michigan and pioneer citizen, organized a bank under the name of the Bank of Lucedale—he became the first president of the bank and was later elected the Chairman of the Board; and

**WHEREAS**, in 1905, the bank moved from it's original modest structure and constructed the very first brick building in the town of Lucedale; and

**WHEREAS**, the bank celebrated its 25<sup>th</sup> anniversary by moving the institution to Main Street which served until 1989—the bank opened its current location in 1989 at the Marketplace Center in Lucedale; and

WHEREAS, in 1976 the bank began to expand into other areas of Mississippi when it opened an office in Hurley—the bank celebrated it 80<sup>th</sup> anniversary by opening an additional office in Escatawpa, Mississippi—in 1999 the bank opened it third office in Jackson County in the town of Vancleave; and

WHEREAS, the Luce family has managed the bank through four generations—Mr Gregory M. Luce was succeeded by his son Jex H. Luce who served until his death in 1958—he was succeeded by his son Douglas T. Luce, Sr. who served as president and Chairman of the Board until his death in 1997—today, the current President, Chief Executive Officer and Chairman of the Board is his son Douglas T. Luce Jr.; and

**WHEREAS,** in 1999 the Bank of Lucedale celebrated 95 years of service to the community by revealing its new vision-Century Bank—the new vision also involved further expansion in the Mobile, Alabama area—the bank now has nine branches in Mississippi and Alabama; and

**NOW, THEREFORE,** in recognition of Century Bank's longstanding commitment to the citizens and communities that it serves, and in honor of its overarching mission of providing sound investment and banking opportunities for the people of Lucedale, South Mississippi, and surrounding areas, I, Governor Ronnie Musgrove, do hereby proclaim Friday, June 27<sup>th</sup>, as

in the State of Mississippi and invite all Mississippians to join with me in celebrating a century of service provided by the people of this outstanding institution
