    - 2. Must be a priority in budget.

  - ii. Classroom technology
    - 1. Computer in every classroom by end of 2002 AOL
      - a. Leading the nation
    - 2. Gates Foundation Grant- teaching technology skills to teachers.
      - a. Only 1 of 7 states to receive it.
    - 3. Magnolia
      - a. Opens up access from university and college libraries to every public library in the state.
