A Proclamation By Governor Ronnie Musgrove

WHEREAS, the enactment of the Older American Act Amendments of 2000 (Public Law 106-501) established an important new program, the National Family Caregiver Support Program (NFCSP), which calls for all states, working in partnership with area agencies on aging and local community-service providers to have five basic services for family caregivers; and

WHEREAS, these five services are: 1.) Information to caregivers about available services, 2.) Assistance to caregivers in gaining access to services, 3.) Individual counseling, organization of support groups, caregiver training to caregivers to assist the caregivers in making decisions and solving problems relating to their caregiving roles, 4.) Respite care to enable caregivers to be temporarily relieved from caregiving responsibilities, 5.) Supplemental services, on a limited basis to complement the care provided by caregivers; and

WHEREAS, in January 2001, the Administration on Aging issued guidance to states on the implementation of the new program—in October 2001, the Mississippi Family Caregiver Support Program began its work in partnership with the ten area agencies on aging to implement the Mississippi program; and

WHEREAS, the Division of Aging and Adult Services works in partnership with the ten area agencies on aging and local community-service providers to provide the services stated above; and

WHEREAS, the theme for the 2002 National Family Caregivers Month is *"Share the Caring"* with the purpose of raising awareness of Family Caregiving issues and expand and enhance services currently provided to family caregivers:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ronnie Musgrove, Governor of the State of Mississippi, hereby proclaim November 2002, as

NATIONAL FAMILY CAREGIVERS MONTH

in the State of Mississippi and do commend family caregivers across our state for their efforts and commitment to their patients.
