HB 301

HB 301 amends Section 37-13-107 to establish the State Department of Education, rather than the Judicial College, as the entity that furnishes a certificate of completion to school attendance officers that attend the required annual training that is provided or approved by the Department of Education.

Current law provides for the Judicial College to provide the certificate of completion and for the Office of Compulsory School Attendance Enforcement of the State Department of Education to approve the training course.

The bill is effective July 1, 2001.

MDE requested that Chairman Warren introduce this bill. No legislators or organizations have voiced opposition to HB 301.
