HB 413

HB 413 amends Section 37-15-31 to provide that if the added territory of a school district does not have a representative on the local school board, then students that reside within the added territory shall have the authority to transfer to the adjacent school district. The accepting school district may not charge any tuition.

HB 413 also authorizes licensed school employees who are nonresidents of Mississippi to enroll their dependent school-age children in the Mississippi school district in which they are employed.

The School Boards Association did not voice any opposition to this bill.

HB 413 is effective July 1, 2001.
