SB 2737

SB 2737 amends current law to authorize the use of auxiliary white lights mounted on or visible from the rear of a motor vehicle with a gross weight not to exceed 12,001 pounds if the lights are designed by the motor vehicle manufacturer or an after-market parts manufacturer so that the lights may only be illuminated when the vehicle is not moving and the transmission cannot transmit power to the wheels.

Discussions of this bill in the House Transportation Committee revolved around technical language. I didn't hear any opposition to the bill.

SB 2737 is effective upon passage.
