WHEREAS, the members of the Mississippi Society of Enrolled Agents voluntarily seek to improve their skills and knowledge through continuing education that exceeds the regulatory mandates of the Internal Revenue Service's Officer of the Director of Practice; and

WHEREAS, the Mississippi Society of Enrolled Agents, an affiliate society of the National Association of Enrolled Agents, provides educational opportunities for its members and the members of other states to gain such education and knowledge:
