The Governor's Office was copied on a letter from Mrs. Burton to State Superintendent of Education Thompson. We received our copy on February 24. Mrs. Burton is concerned over the Lee County School Board's application for approval of the ZapMe! Program. According to Mrs. Burton, ZapMe! Provides 15 computers to the schools, but then requires students to receive an electronic ID in order to use the computers. Mrs. Burton fears that ZapMe! has designed the computers to serve as the front end of a sophisticated marketing and advertising scheme.

I prepared correspondence for the Governor's signature expressing appreciation for her concern over protecting the privacy of children and protecting them from marketing schemes and encouraging her to share her concerns with her local educational leaders.
