

A Proclamation

WHEREAS, individual and organized forms of recreation and use of leisure time are vital to the lives of all Americans, especially persons with physical, mental, emotional and/or social limitations; and

WHEREAS, the purpose of therapeutic recreation is accomplished through the provision of programs and services which assist in eliminating barriers to leisure, developing leisure skills and attitudes, and optimizing leisure involvement; and

WHEREAS, the National Therapeutic Recreation Society, a branch of the National Recreation and Park Association, originated a week of observances to focus on the value of recreation and leisure experiences for all persons, including those with physical, mental, emotional and/or social limitations:

NOW, THEREFORE, I, Ronnie Musgrove, Governor of the State of Mississippi, hereby proclaim July 13 through July 19, 2003, as

NATIONAL THERAPEUTIC RECREATION WEEK

in the State of Mississippi, and I urge all citizens to support this observance, and to promote and enhance the quality of life for persons with physical, mental, emotional, and/or social limitations.
