SB 2385

SB 2385 amends current law to allow vehicles with a handicapped license plate or a disabled veteran license plate to park in a handicapped parking space even if they don't have the removable handicapped windshield placard.

As introduced, SB 2385 only allowed cars with handicapped license plates to park in a handicapped space without the placard. Senator Rob Smith introduced the amendment in the Senate Transportation Committee for the disabled vets tag to be included in the bill and the amendment passed.

SB 2385 is effective July 1, 2002.

I recommend that you sign SB 2385.
