HB 642

HB 642 allows the State Superintendent of Education to designate an appropriate individual to serve in his place on three state boards – the Authority for Educational Television, the Council for Education Technology and the Work Force Development Advisory Council.

HB 642 is effective July 1, 2002.

MDE requested this bill and reported in the House and Senate Education Committee that it is necessary due to the number of boards, councils or commissions that the State Superintendent serves on. I have not heard of or received any opposition to this bill.
