

Section One:

The Governor's Policy and Planning Division works internally with state agencies to develop new and innovative ways of improving public service and the lives of every Mississippian. From public finance to public health, interns will have the opportunity to do area-specific research, work on independent projects and interact with state agencies.

Section Two:

The Governor's Policy and Planning Division will achieve two objectives through an active internship program. 1) The Division will be able to test the research and management abilities of interns through a progressively structured policy internship program. 2) Interns will be responsible for drafting sample policies and program ideas for review.

Section Three:

Interns will have opportunities to experience the policymaking process from the state's chief executive perspective. In addition, interns will have an opportunity to select an area of interest with a myriad of state agencies to learn operations and policy issues facing state government and Mississippians. Interns will also have opportunities to assist with constituent concerns and requests.
