<i>Journal of Law and Economics</i>	explores the complex relationships between law and economics, focusing on the influence of regulation and legal institutions on the operation of economic systems...articles are most often concerned with how markets behave and w/ the actual effects of governmental institutions on markets.	semi-annually; 250 pages/issue	\$45 (1-yr); \$81 (2-yr)
<i>Social Service Review</i>	examines social welfare policy and practice and evaluates its effects; articles include topics such as child welfare, health care, social welfare policy, homelessness, community, clinical practice, and juvenile delinquency	quarterly; 176 pgs/ issue	\$96
<i>Journal of Political Economy</i>	analytical, interpretative and emperical studies; work in areas of monetary theory, fiscal policy, labor economics, planning & dev't, micro- and macroeconomic theory, international trade and finance, industrial organization	bimonthly; 224 pgs/issue	\$159
