During the opening session, you will be asked to make a few comments highlighting a conservation program in Mississippi. SGA has allotted 3-4 minutes per Governor. As you will recall, we worked with SGA and Governor Foster's office to conduct a site visit in the Mississippi Delta earlier this year to draw attention to the Lower Delta Partnership.

- The Lower Delta Partnership mission is to promote and enhance the economic and environmental health of the Mississippi's Lower Delta.
- The partnership includes U.S. Fish & Wildlife; The Nature Conservancy; U.S. Forest Service; MS Department of Wildlife, Fisheries, and Parks; DEQ; MDA-Tourism, MS Forestry Commission, and others.
- More than 200,000 acres of public and private forested conservation lands included and targeted in the partnership.
- On October 19, 2002, we will host the "Great Delta Bear Affair" in Rolling Fork commemorating Teddy Roosevelt's famed bear hunt.
