An overview of events in which you directly participate is provided below.

Sunday, 10:30 a.m., SGPB Business Meeting: I don't have an agenda for the meeting as of this time. As vice-chairman and incoming chairman, you should sit at the head table.

Sunday, 1:30-3:00 p.m., Panel Presentation of the 2002 Report on the Future of the South (See Tab 1): I've included the panel description provided by SGPB. I've also included an analysis and a copy of the report in this briefing book. The report focuses on the impact of the automotive industry in recent years on the South – it is the region's new means of advancing and competing in the workforce. Focus on our accomplishments with Nissan and Nissan's impact on our state: Nissan suppliers are diverse and offer opportunities to all; Nissan is reinvesting in the future and ensuring its workforce by offering the annual scholarships to high school students.

Monday, 6:00 p.m., Governor's Banquet: This is the formal dinner where all of the SGPB governors in attendance are announced into the banquet room.

Tuesday, 10:00-11:30 a.m., "Conversations on the Future of the South" panel discussion (See Tab 2): This session is designed to launch a new line of discussion about the future of the South. Governor Hodges will moderate this "town meeting" style panel discussion. I've included the panel description provided by SGPB in this briefing book, as well as suggested speaking points. Although the panel discussion starts at 10:00, it will be taped so **you need to be in the room at 9:45** to get wired for sound and last minute instructions.

Tuesday, 11:30-11:45 a.m., Closing Ceremony: Governor Hodges will pass the chairman's gavel to you at this time. You can talk briefly about the direction of next year's work ("leadership") and they you should invite everyone to next year's annual meeting at the Beau Rivage in Biloxi, June 1-3.
