Closing gaps in success at colleges and universities

(There is a major problem here, especially for university students, and the Texas work is important for other states to know about.)

< Reading

(One of the keys to closing gaps; use new NAEP results to push the case for more and continuing work.)

< Technology

(The education technology Action Agenda announced by Governor Musgrove and the Executive Committee is a long-term effort. This Board meeting should be a part of this effort.)

< Leadership

Ultimately education leadership will largely determine if we have qualified and effective teachers. The multi-year, multi-million dollars redesign of school leadership programs will be at a "telling point" in June. We think this may deserve time on the Board's agenda.
