Mississippi's AOL@SCHOOL will feature a "Mississippi Feature Window," customized and programmed by our own education officials, which will appear when AOL@SCHOOL is accessed from a school. This feature will automatically appear for every Mississippi user who registers for AOL@SCHOOL and will provide access to initiatives and resources specific to our needs. In addition to the "Mississippi Feature Window," the AOL@SCHOOL software also includes programmable "My School" and "My District" tool bar buttons, which allow you to program the URL's for your local sites directly into the tool bar.

Enclosed is an AOL@SCHOOL information and installation packet. Individual schools will need to identify one person (or a few for larger schools) to be their AOL@SCHOOL Account Manager. This person is in charge of the local control of student access levels, changing passwords, as well as editing e-mail access and controls.
