Press Conference with Governor Riley
April 11, 2003*

- Had a good meeting this morning with Governor Riley
 - Discussed our mutual goals of creating quality jobs for our people

- Pleased to say we are going to move forward with the implementation of a regional alliance
 - Focus on attracting jobs and industry to our shared border

- As a result of our meeting here today, we are moving to the next step
 - Developing a formal agreement for our signatures

- Once agreement is reached, Bob Rohrlack and Neal Wade of Alabama Development Office will tour the world touting the alliance

- Impact of the national recession has hit our states hard
 - We've been forced to think and act in new and innovative ways
 - Change the way we invest in our future

- We've done it by raising our investment in education to 62 percent of our general fund

- We've done it by passing the Mississippi Rural Economic Impact Authority to assist rural communities with economic development efforts
 - Worker training at junior and community colleges

- We started this work three years ago with passage of Advantage Mississippi Initiative
 - Initiative provided for creation of regional economic development alliances across state lines at county/municipal levels

- Industries are looking for best incentives to locate facilities, invest money and create jobs
 - A regional alliance like this one will be attractive to them
 - Alliance will give them strong return on investment

- More important, alliance will improve quality of life for citizens of our states
 - That's the bottom line
 - Focus on building good schools, good jobs, good communities

- Want to thank Governor Riley and his team for their commitment to reaching across state lines to work together on this issue
 - Also want to thank East Mississippi Business Development Corporation for their dedication to making this alliance a reality
