

Bills in Conference as of 3/24/03

Education Bills

- HB 742 School districts; revise certain sections relating to the administration of (Warren) (DUPLICATE TO SB 2395)
- HB 746 Schools; exempt from 180-day minimum school calendar for time missed due to emergencies (Warren)
- SB 2395 Statutes providing for administration of school districts; make technical amendments to (Harden) (DUPLICATE TO HB 742)
- SB 2404 School calendar requirements and adequate education program payments for school days missed due to emergencies; clarify (Harden)
- SB 2412 Automatic repealers on certain public education programs; delete (Harden)
- SB 2587 Duties of school bus drivers upon approaching railroad crossing; to open service door and driver's window (Dickerson)
- SB 2636 Early Childhood Education programs assessment; authorize (Harden)

Transportation Bills

- HB 442 Highway 18 in Jasper County; designate portion as "Tom Royce Green Memorial Highway" (Stringer)
- HB 1095 Traffic tickets; authorized to be issued electronically (DPS) (Compretta)
- SB 2475 Highway 45 bridge over MS 19; designate as Military Order of the Purple Heart, Department of Mississippi, Memorial Bridge (Carmichael)
- SB 2676 Annual overweight load permits; may be issued by MDOT for vehicles transporting heavy equipment with a GVW of 140,000 pounds or less (Harvey)
- SB 2709 Windshield placards for the disabled; must be displayed by hanging them from the rearview mirror of the vehicle (Dickerson)
- SB 2814 Highways; provide that contracts for construction and maintenance shall be awarded to the lowest and best responsible bidder (Gollott)
