HB 774

HB 774 extends the repealer on the following until 2007:

- School Crisis Management Program
- Transfer of the Industrial Training and Short-term training programs to the State Board for Community and Junior Colleges (NOTE: You have already signed SB 2037 which deleted the repealer on this program, so the program's repealer will now be extended until 2007.)
- School Administrator Sabbatical Leave Program
- The expulsion authority for habitually disruptive students
- The conflict resolution-peer mediation curricula requirement
- The evidence of date of birth for enrollment in kindergarten or first grade

MDE supports this bill. The bill started out in the House just eliminating the repealers, but the sub-committee amended the bill to extend repealers until 2007.

The Senate has a duplicate bill – SB 2412. The House has amended it, but the Senate has declined to concur and it is going to conference. I'll talk to Joe Warren to make sure that SB 2412 just dies in conference since this one is on your desk.

HB 774 is effective June 30, 2002.
