We have been notified by NGA that we are 1 of 5 states (Mississippi, Missouri, Utah, Vermont and Wyoming) selected to participate in the NGA Center for Best Practices Interdisciplinary Network on School Health Benefits. Ours was 1 of 10 applications received by NGA. The purpose of this 2-year NGA initiative is to support five states in building and sustaining community-school partnerships that promote school health and improve academic achievement.
