Kristen Conklin of the NGA staff has emailed me to give me a heads up that Ray Sheppach is inviting you to speak at an upcoming NGA event on college access to be held in DC on Wednesday, October 17. The agenda for event is attached and reflects that you and Governors Hoeven, O'Bannon, Perry and Wise have been invited to speak from 9:30 to 10:00 a.m on "The State Priority of Expanded College Opportunity." National Public Radio has indicated interest in taping the event.
