- We also made the applications available at the MDA's regional offices located across the state as well as on the <u>www.mississippiandnissan.com</u> website with a link from our website.
- As a result of these efforts, we are thrilled to announce that the Mississippi and Nissan website, received more than 306,971 hits since our statewide tour, and more than 4,901 applications were downloaded from this site.
- Nissan officials have received an outstanding number of applications from Mississippi companies and are expecting to receive the applications throughout the day today.
- That means Mississippians acted.
- That means Mississippi businesses took this opportunity to apply as suppliers for Nissan.

- That means more Mississippians and Mississippi businesses benefiting from Nissan's decision to locate in our state.
- This is a terrific opportunity for Mississippians to grow and improve their businesses---right here at home.
