Keeping education a priority with a budget that puts Schools First / 62 percent

Budget is key issue of legislative session

- Must budget based on real numbers, not on hope
- Recognize House and Senate for historic action
- o Funding education at 62%
- o Fully funding MAEP for the first time
- o Funds teacher pay raise
- Addresses needs of higher education, including nursing school

Brain trust focuses on stopping flow of best and brightest out of MS

- o 10 year commitment of \$200M matched by universities and colleges
- Build MS's intellectual capacity / research capabilities
- O Grants for graduate assistants to stay in MS / cultivate teachers
- More momentum for economic development
- We've invested hundreds of millions of dollars in buildings
