- It's good to be here with you tonight
 - Appreciate opportunity to share thoughts about my own faith and the faith I have in this great state of ours
- I believe Mississippi is going through a revival
 - o In its commitment to making the most of the promise of *all* its people, in all areas of the state

 - o Each of us benefits from good schools, good jobs and good communities
- I pray every day for the strength and the wisdom to do this job, a job that I love
 - I ask for your prayers as well, to do work that serves our people and serves
 God
- That work includes doing everything we can to come together

- o Not just as Mississippians but as creations of God
- o Made in His image, and blessed by His grace
- We can do this / it's happening right now
 - o It's helping make a better, stronger, healthier Mississippi
 - o I'm thankful for it
