- I am sure the teachers, parents and students here agree with me that education <u>must be our top</u> <u>priority in Mississippi</u>.
- We <u>have</u> taken one of the largest steps forward for our state, to make education a top priority, by passing legislation to raise teacher pay to the Southeastern average.
- A raise in teacher salaries is an <u>investment</u> in our <u>teachers and</u> our <u>students</u>.
