- 1) Who will work in the Governor's Office on Friday, November 10th?
 - * Administrative leave has been requested by DFA for all agencies moving.
 - * People cannot be on the 20th Floor Sillers or 15th Floor Woolfolk.
 - * The main phone (93150) will be forwarded to 93100 at the Capitol.
 - * There will be NO computer service on Friday, November 10th.
 - * Please remember that <u>all</u> computers will be shut down on Thursday, November 9th at 3:00pm. This includes the servers for the Governor's Office and DFA.
- 2) When will the staff start unpacking the office in Woolfolk?
 - *The movers have said that the move will be completed by Friday night for the Governor's Office.
