

PAGE PROGRAM

Governor Musgrove's Page Program is designed to provide students with an opportunity to work in the Office of the Governor during the Legislative session. Students are given a unique opportunity to see how the Office of the Governor works on a day-to-day basis.

In order to apply, students must (1) be enrolled in 9th-12th grade, (2) have a "B" average or higher, (3) submit a letter to the Governor stating why he/she wishes to become a Page, and (4) submit letters of recommendation from a teacher, an administrator (such as a principal), and one personal recommendation (such as a pastor or family friend).
