

**A Proclamation  
By  
Governor Ronnie Musgrove**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Mississippi is a key supplier of U.S. grown rice, producing more than 1.485 billion pounds annually; and

**WHEREAS**, rice is the staple grain for two-thirds of the population of the world, and the significance of rice cannot be overemphasized; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States produces more than 20 billion pounds annually; and

**WHEREAS**, rice is the fifth most valuable food crop in the Nation, as rice represents a two-billion-dollar cash crop, and is vital to the economic stability of rice farmers and millers in Texas, Mississippi, California, Louisiana, Arkansas, Missouri and Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, intense research and development in rice technology has resulted in rice farmers producing some of the highest yield of rice per acre, making rice one of the most land-efficient and cost-efficient crops grown; and

**WHEREAS**, the United States is one of the largest exporters of rice, as this Nation exports rice to over one hundred countries and supplies about fifteen percent of the rice for world trade; and

**WHEREAS**, millions of people in this Nation, as well as countless people in other countries, enjoy rice in a variety of forms, including the use of rice as an edible grain, in flour, bran, cooking oil, cereal, rice cakes and health food snacks; and

**WHEREAS**, rice is an important source of nutritional value, as rice provides an excellent source of complex carbohydrates, and is cholesterol-free and sodium-free; and

**WHEREAS**, rice is recognized worldwide as an economical food and an important part of feeding the expanding population in Third World nations; and

**WHEREAS**, rice provides an important contribution to the diet, to the economy of Mississippi and this Nation, and to the nourishment of other countries; and

**WHEREAS**, rice farmers of Mississippi represent a key element in the enhancement of the environment and of habitats for waterfowl such as ducks, geese swans, cranes and others; and

**WHEREAS**, the harvest of rice in the United States is celebrated each September:

**NOW, THEREFORE**, I, Ronnie Musgrove, Governor of the State of Mississippi, hereby proclaim September 2002, as

**MISSISSIPPI RICE MONTH**

in the State of Mississippi.
