Governor Musgrove Names Briggs Hopson, III to the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission

Jackson, Miss. – Governor Ronnie Musgrove appointed Briggs Hopson, III, of Vicksburg to a five-year term of office ending May 5, 2005, to the Mississippi Veterans Memorial Stadium Commission.

Hopson will represent an at large position for his term. He is a graduate of the University of Mississippi School of Law, where he Law School Student Body President. He was admitted to the Louisiana Bar in 1990 and the Mississippi Bar in 1991.

Currently, Hopson serves on the United Way Board of Directors and the University of Mississippi Alumni Association Board of Directors. He is also a member of the Legislative Liaison Committee, the Lamar Order and the American Cancer Society.
