A Proclamation By Governor Ronnie Musgrove

WHEREAS, Dr. Bobby L. Shelby, a native of Flora, Mississippi, is the son of the late Tommy Shelby and the late Lillie Shelby; and

WHEREAS, he married Mrs. Josie Daniel Shelby, a native of Pocahontas, Mississippi, on August 4, 1937 and they have thirteen children, twenty-nine grandchildren and twenty-three great grandchildren; and

WHEREAS, a graduate of Hinds County Public Schools, Reverend Shelby has earned an Associate of Arts degree from Utica Junior College and, in 1963, he earned his Bachelor of Theology from the Mississippi Baptist Seminary in Jackson, Mississippi—in 1982, he received his Master of Theology Degree and in 1984, he completed his Doctorate of Ministry from the Mississippi Baptist Seminary; and

WHEREAS, Dr. Shelby began his service in the ministry at the White Oak Baptist Church in Tougaloo, Mississippi—he also served as an associate pastor of Cade Chapel in Jackson, Mississippi, and pastor of China Grove Missionary Baptist Church in Prentiss, Mississippi; and
