I asked our Gaming Commission to adopt the same restrictions that Nevada placed on Mr . Engelstad's gaming license, but the Commission declined. However, Commissioner Rob ert Engram pledged for the Gaming Commision to revoke Mr. Engelstad's license if ther e was even a single incident of glorifying Hitler by Mr. Engelstad or the Imperial Pa lace Casino.

You may refer to the article in the CLARION-LEDGER on 09/03/94, "No Nazi parties at c asino, gaming commisioner warns owner".

Whomever you decide to appoint to our Gaming Commission, I urge you to consider the s tanding commitment by the Gaming Commission not to permit any form of activity by any casino that is considered to be offensive to any racial, ethnic or religious group.
