contacts I made researching this proposed amendment is a con law professor;=20
he just had a fit to think that I had even considered requesting judicial=20
review because it violated the separation of powers in the federal=20
government. (I got the impression that he wasn't going to be much help in=20
the future!!!)

When the Court rules on these motions or when any other information comes to=

my attention, I will relay the information to you.
