**GOVERNOR MUSGROVE AWARDS SMALL MUNICIPALITY PUBLIC FACILITIES
GRANT TO TOWN OF COMO**

JACKSON, Miss. – Governor Ronnie Musgrove recently announced a Small Municipality Public Facilities Grant awarded to the Town of Como through the Community Development Block Grant program. The \$300,000 grant was administered by the Mississippi Development Authority (MDA), which also approves grant recipients.

“The state of Mississippi welcomes the opportunity to support our communities in improving infrastructure and other services. Strong communities build a strong economy and a better way of life for our citizens,” commented Governor Ronnie Musgrove.

The grant will be used to fund water improvements in the community.
