ooks have been written about this tragedy. One of the books written by Cassie Brown
is entitled STANDING INTO DANGER. Another book written by Henry Strauss who was a su

led Heroes of the Frozen Cliffs. A Canadian newspaper man has written a screenplay

USS POLLUX (AKS-4) was rushed into commission on 27 April 1942 to replace the AKS-2. She served proudly during WWII, Korea and Vietnam winning several battle stars. She helped evacuate the first POW's to be freed by our troops in the Manila area at the end of WWII. She was decommissioned on 31 December 1968 by CAPTAIN CHARLES N. FLITTON. Captain Flitton will be in attendance at our Biloxi reunion.
