A Proclamation By Governor Ronnie Musgrove

WHEREAS, our vast and complex system of justice cannot function without the skills and dedication of our nation's legal support staff; and

WHEREAS, legal support staff provide vital administrative and technical assistance to our courts, government, business and private law; and
