YOROZU TO HOLD GRAND OPENING

FLOWERS, Miss – The official grand opening of Yorozu Automotive Mississippi Inc.'s new manufacturing facility, a supplier to the Nissan North America plant under construction in Canton, Mississippi, has been set. The ceremony will be held May 1, 2003, beginning at 2:00 p.m. in the Ceres Research and Industrial Interplex on Interstate 20 in Flowers, which is just east of Vicksburg.
