GOVERNOR MUSGROVE AWARDS CAP LOAN TO CITY OF MORTON

JACKSON, Miss. – Governor Ronnie Musgrove recently announced the latest Capital Improvements Revolving Loan Program (CAP) loan awarded to the City of Morton.

“The state of Mississippi recognizes the efforts of our communities to create a pro-business environment that promotes economic development. This loan demonstrates our commitment to help communities attract jobs and a better way of life for our citizens,” commented Governor Musgrove.

The City of Morton receives CAP Loan funds through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program in the amount of \$75,000 for public facilities improvements.

CDBG is a program of the Community Services Division of the Mississippi Development Authority. Among the division’s goals are assisting communities in analyzing their strengths and weaknesses, involving their leadership in economic development, planning development strategies, strengthening development organizations, and implementing and financing community projects.
