GOVERNOR MUSGROVE AWARDS COMMUNITY SELF HELP GRANT TO CITY OF INDIANOLA

JACKSON, Miss. – Governor Ronnie Musgrove recently announced the latest Community Self-Help Grant awarded to the City of Indianola.

“The state of Mississippi is pleased to offer financial support to our communities as they work to improve the quality of life for our citizens and to build a strong foundation for economic growth throughout the state,” commented Governor Musgrove.

The City of Indianola receives Community Self-Help funds through the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) program in the amount of \$100,000 to rehabilitate and renovate the B.B. King Park in South Indianola.

CDBG is a program of the Community Services Division of the Mississippi Development Authority. Among the division’s goals are assisting communities in analyzing their strengths and weaknesses, involving their leadership in economic development, planning development strategies, strengthening development organizations, and implementing and financing community projects. The Community Services Division also administers other Economic Development grant and loan programs.
