Tupelo WIN Job Center Hosts Open House

The Workforce Investment Act of 1998, known as WIA, provides the framework for WIN in Mississippi and is administered statewide by the Employment Training Division of the Mississippi Development Authority.

"Every WIN Job Center is a local connection that brings together extensive resources and information under one roof," said Jim Lott, director of the Employment Training Division. "For example, job seekers can access job training, education, and employment services, and employers can post job openings and get current information on the skills their workers will need to be competitive – all at one location."

WIN in Mississippi is delivered locally through six Workforce Investment Areas, including the Mississippi Partnership that serves 27 counties in north Mississippi. Partners in this area include: Mississippi Employment Security Commission, Itawamba Community College, Mississippi Department of Rehabilitation Services, Mississippi Department of Education, and Mississippi Department of Human Services.

The Tupelo WIN Job Center is open daily from 8:00 am to 5:00 pm, except on Wednesdays, when it closes at 4:00 pm.
