**WHEREAS,** Craig has participated in the Special Olympics for three years in track and field and in bowling events and has won many awards including 1<sup>st</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> place; and

WHEREAS, Craig has participated and ridden in disabled horse shows and received many first place ribbons—he has also ridden in the Dixie National Rodeo for two years and has participated in many 4-H shows including riding in the state finals; and

WHEREAS, Craig lives his life by exemplifying two mottos: "Success is measured not so much by the position that one has reached in life as by the obstacles which one has overcome while trying to succeed." and "The greatest pleasure in life is doing what people say you cannot do;" and

**WHEREAS,** Craig has been an employee with Winn-Dixie since April 2000 and has received the top twelve-employee award three times since it began in 2001; and

WHEREAS, he is highly regarded and well liked by his fellow employees and management of Winn-Dixie; and

WHEREAS, he is an active member of the Antioch Baptist Church and his Pastor considers his life to be a miracle especially because of the extent of his injuries at age three and his success of being independent at age nineteen; and

WHEREAS, Anthony Craig Sawyer is a true role model to other disabled people and has become a contributing member of our society—he participates in community events, church activities, is employed, pays taxes, and has a zest for life that is truly contagious:
