The Mississippi Emergency Management Agency (MEMA) is closely monitoring the projected path of Tropical Storm Isidore. The following information is being provided to citizens to aid in their safe response to Tropical Storm Isidore.

ROAD CLOSURES

STATE HIGHWAYS

- 1. US 90 impassable from the Ocean Springs drawbridge to the Bay S. Louis drawbridge.
- 2. The southbound lanes of US 49 just south of McHenry impassable due to water on the highway. Mississippi Department of Transportation crews are working to get highway open.
- 3. Water reported over Highway 67 in Harrison County from Old 67 to the New Traditions Subdivision.
- 4. Highway 613 just south of the high rise at Moss Point all four lanes under water. Law enforcement is on the scene.
- **5.** The entire length of Highway 604 in Hancock County is under water and impassable.
