Governor Ronnie Musgrove Kicks Off 100th Day Celebration With Teacher Pay Raise Bill Signing

Governor Ronnie Musgrove celebrated his 100th day in office by signing the teacher pay raise bill that he campaigned for and worked diligently to pass during this legislative session. At 3:30 p.m. today, children, parents, teachers, legislators, business people, along with friends and family members helped Governor Musgrove celebrate both the passage of the teacher pay raise bill on the day that marks
